Parade begins promptly at 6:00 p.m. and will proceed North along Main Street from 500 South to 500 North

(Arrange for generators early)

Business and Family entries are welcome

- The street lights along Main Street will be turned off--all entries must be lit with Christmas Lights.
- The committee reserves the right to review and limit entries for appropriateness as to the Christmas theme. This is a family oriented parade and we expect to always exhibit that theme.
- If your entry will have objects or persons on the float, we suggest you use spot specific lighting to illuminate them. Without supplemental lighting, they will not be visible in the dark.
- If you want your name to be seen by spectators, you should also design your float in such a way as to illuminate letters, logos, etc.
- Remember that this is a non-competitive parade--you are all winners.
- You can arrange for a generator by contacting Jorgensen's Honda or one of our other fine businesses.
- Bring plenty of gas on hand to run your generator.
- We reserve a place for Santa on the Coca Cola truck at the end of the parade. So that young children are not confused by "multiple" Santa's--please decorate your entry with other festive ideas.
- **ABSOLUTELY NO ITEMS CAN BE THROWN** or distributed in any manner from parade entry along the parade route.
- We encourage you to park your entry for display at the City Park along Richfield's Main Street following the parade. If you would like to display your entry, please contact Richfield City to reserve a spot in the park. The City donates the electricity to power your lights during the time your entry is displayed.
